

Health Notes

Please be mindful of not only your own child's health, but also of all the other little ones who are such a special part of our church family. We have some with fragile immune systems and exposure to what may be a mild virus for some can become a lengthy illness for others. Children who show signs of illness cannot be accepted for childcare. If uncertain, please err on the side of caution, in the interest of keeping our children (including yours) healthy.

A child should not be left in the nursery when any of the following exists:

1. Fever above 100 degrees F (should be free of fever for at least 24 hours).
2. Intestinal disturbance accompanied by diarrhea or vomiting.
3. Any undiagnosed rash.
4. Sore or discharging eyes or ears, profuse colored nasal drainage.
5. Any communicable or infectious disease (measles, mumps, chicken pox, whooping cough etc.).

If your child becomes ill with a contagious disease following a nursery care session, please inform the church office so other parents may take proper precautions with their children.

Nursery Caregivers Will:

- Not administer any type of medication to the children in their care.
- Check baby diapers frequently to see if they need changing.
- Change diapers only on the changing table or a changing pad. The table or pad will be cleaned and disinfected after each changing.
- Wear disposable gloves while changing a diaper and discard after each diaper change and/or wash and disinfect hands after each diaper change or trip to the toilet. Toddlers will also wash their hands after each trip to the toilet.
- Strip and disinfect beds after each use.
- Offer aid in a positive, non-threatening manner, to individual children who experience difficulty in the group or who temporarily lose their physical or emotional control. Any special concerns or problems that arise will be shared with parents.
- Immediately discard broken toys that pose a hazard to the children.
- Maintain an orderly physical environment, supervise play activities and enforce safety rules.
- Pick up toys and disinfect them after church services each week.

Welcome to Our Nursery!

At Creekwood Christian Church we are committed to providing a safe, secure, loving environment for the youngest members and guests of our church. Our nursery caregivers make every effort to help the children feel comfortable and happy in a clean, stimulating and well-supervised environment.

Pagers

When you bring your child to the nursery you will be given a pager. Be sure the pager is turned on (a vibration signifies that it is working.)

Should your child need your attention, an attendant will page you. Your child will be released to your care upon turning in the pager.

Policies

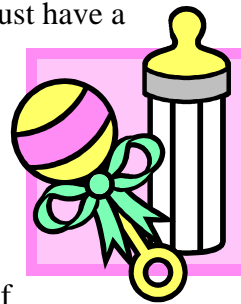
Nursery care is available for children during Sunday morning worship services and Sunday School until promotion in August, following the third birthday, when children “graduate” into a Sunday School class and begin coming to Godly Play during worship services. (Mid-year promotion with approval of Children’s Minister.)

Childcare is also available at selected church activities (noted with an asterisk in the newsletter and worship bulletin.) The nursery will be open ten minutes prior to and ten minutes following Sunday services and church events with childcare.

Parents should pick up children as soon as possible following the service or activity, as children may feel anxious about being left behind when the other children have gone.

Children in the nursery must have a registration card on file.

All belongings - bags, bottles, pacifiers, cups... should be labeled. For the children's safety, no gum, candy or outside toys (with the exception of security "lovies") are allowed in the nursery.



We have a “no nut” policy, in order to protect children with nut allergies. Please do not allow any peanut/nut products into the nursery with your child or in their belongings.



Cry Room

During worship services, a “cry room” is available for the convenience of parents with young babies. The room, which is entered beside the Welcome Booth, has a one-way window view into the sanctuary and the sound system is connected to the room as well. A volume control switch is located just outside the cry room, on the wall beside the door of the Godly Play room. Parents are welcome to use this area should they need to leave the service for any reason.
